How we collect and use (process) your personal information

As with other companies, we collect personal data through various channels including, but not limited to, the following channels:

We do not collect 'sensitive data' about you.

We will store your details on Win-Dor's CRM databases and accounts systems respectively, in accordance with our marketing data storage and retention policy.

How we use your personal information:

We may contact you via email with information about offers or promotions we believe will be of interest to you. You can change your preferences or remove your consent at any time by unsubscribing, e-mailing, telephoning or writing to us.

We also use personal information for the purposes of administering and expanding our business activities, providing customer service and making available our products and services to our customers and prospective customers.

If you make an enquiry to us via our website, by email or telephone, we may offer you an opportunity to consent to us storing your personal data for us to send you information relating to your enquiry, on an ongoing basis, until you tell us not to.

When and how we share information with others

It is therefore necessary for us to register every installation with the appropriate authorities; and this will include our passing on some of your personal data (e.g. Name, Address and Details of Products/Installation) to FIRAS, FENSA and/or the British Standards Institute.
